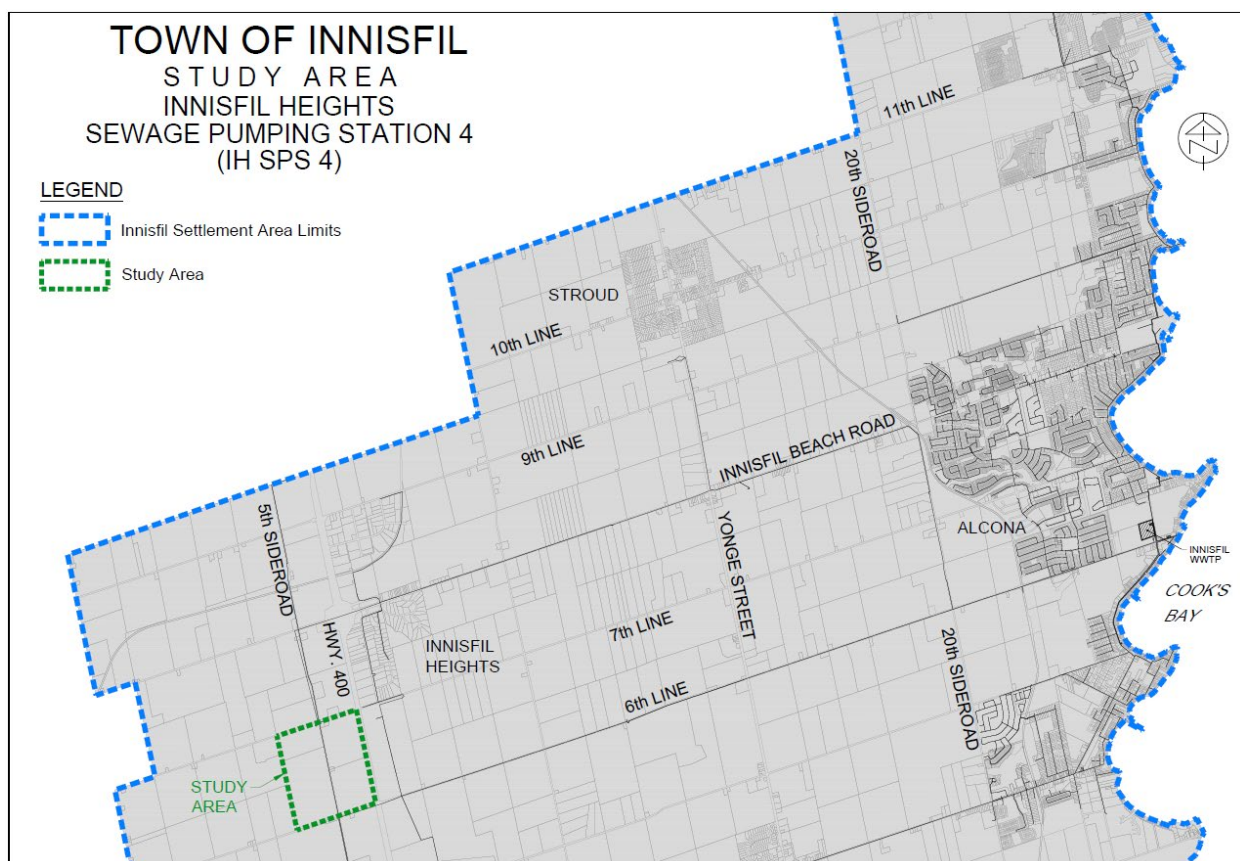
Class Environmental Assessment – Innisfil Heights Sewage Pumping Station 4 (IH SPS 4)

The Study

InnServices Utilities Inc. is commencing a Schedule ‘B’ Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Innisfil Heights Sewage Pumping Station 4 (IH SPS 4). This study has been identified through the Town of Innisfil’s 2023 Master Servicing Plan Update and is required to support planned growth within the Innisfil Heights Employment Area.

The purpose of the study is to evaluate the need for additional sanitary pumping infrastructure and to identify a preferred solution for conveying ultimate build-out wastewater flows to the Lakeshore Water Pollution Control Plant. The EA will examine the siting of a new sewage pumping station as well as the associated forcemain alignment. The assessment will also consider property requirements, hydraulic capacity, power supply, constructability, environmental constraints, staging, and long-term operational efficiency.

The Innisfil Heights Sewage Pumping Station 4 study area is proposed to be located on 5th Sideroad between 6th Line and 7th Line, as shown on the map below.



The Process

InnServices has retained Ainley Group to complete and document a Schedule B Class EA in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Document, February 2024.

Public consultation is a key component of the Class EA process. Additional information will be made available once alternatives have been identified and evaluated. Advance notice will be provided to allow all interested parties an opportunity to comment.
