Terms and Conditions:

1.	Water obtained through hydrants shall not be considered potable, due to the filling and transportation of this water not being regulated.
2.	The use of a hydrant meter is a privilege and at the discretion of the operating authority, if the privilege is being abused, the meter will be removed, and the privilege revoked.
3.	Any damage or changes to the configuration of the meter or backflow prevention device will result in fees charged equivalent to the actual cost to restore the apparatus to its original state.
4.	InnServices may restrict the water usage in the event of a water ban or restriction, as per the Town's Outdoor Water Conservation By-Law.
5.	No person, other than a person authorized by the operating authority (InnServices) for that purpose, or those acting specifically under their direction, shall open or close a valve in the waterworks, or remove, tamper with or in any way interfere with any valve, water meter, structure, watermain or water service connection in the waterworks. Upon permit approval, a meter assembly will be provided, installed, and removed by InnServices Staff. At no time is the



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	applicant or their forces to operate the fire hydrant.								
6.	InnServices may grant, revoke, or deny approval for hydrant meter use at its discretion and such approval shall be supplied upon such terms as InnServices deems necessary.								
7.	All water passing through the meter shall be charged for, whether used or wasted.								
8.	A copy of this permit shall be kept at the hydrant site by the consumer for verification purposes.								
9.	No person supplied with a hydrant meter assembly and permit to use shall be entitled to use such water for any purpose(s) other than that stated on this application. Water may be obtained from hydrants for the following operations: <table><tr><td>- Pavement Flushing</td><td>- Compacting of Backfill</td></tr><tr><td>- Sewer Flushing</td><td>- Concrete Cutting</td></tr><tr><td>- Dust Control and Road Construction</td><td>- Soil Testing</td></tr><tr><td>- Sodding</td><td>- Well Points</td></tr></table>	- Pavement Flushing	- Compacting of Backfill	- Sewer Flushing	- Concrete Cutting	- Dust Control and Road Construction	- Soil Testing	- Sodding	- Well Points
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10.	If the deposit made as part of this application and the water or service provided to the applicant is not paid for on demand, then the deposit or so much thereof as shall be necessary, shall be applied in payment for such water and the service thereupon discontinued until further monies have been paid to InnServices sufficient to bring the deposit again to the amount required.								
11.	During the freezing weather, all hydrant meters must be removed from the hydrants each evening. If you wish to continue usage, install and removal charges will be levied for each day the hydrant meter remains in place. Alternatively, an insulated box surrounding the hydrant may be used at InnServices discretion.								
12.	Laying hoses from hydrants across sidewalks and travelled roadways must be avoided if possible. When absolutely necessary, the hose must be protected with proper planking and safe passage of pedestrian and vehicular traffic.
